# Use houses to test your observation, focus, and memory skills. 

Age: 10+
Players: 2+

## Contents

3 sheets with 12 images of houses each

## Suggested Supplies

Printer and cardstock paper
Scissors to cut out each photo

## How to Play

1. Determine the number of players.
2. The youngest player goes first.
3. Print out each sheet with photos twice and cut them out.
4. Mix up the photos and lay them face down on a flat surface.
5. Use all 72 photos ( 36 pairs) by laying them out in 9 rows horizontally and 8 columns vertically.
6. If desired, beginners can use less photos to start, either one sheet or two sheets, but make sure to provide a match for each photo.
7. Each player takes a turn turning over any two cards to reveal the photo.
8. If two cards match identically, keep them and place them to the side.
9. If they don't match, turn them back over and try to remember each card and where it was for the next turn.
10. Watch and remember your opponent's turn, too.
11. When all the cards have been matched, the game is over and the player with the most matched photos wins!

## Helpful Hint

Although the game is designed for two or more players, you can practice on your own. The more you practice, the better your memory will get!
